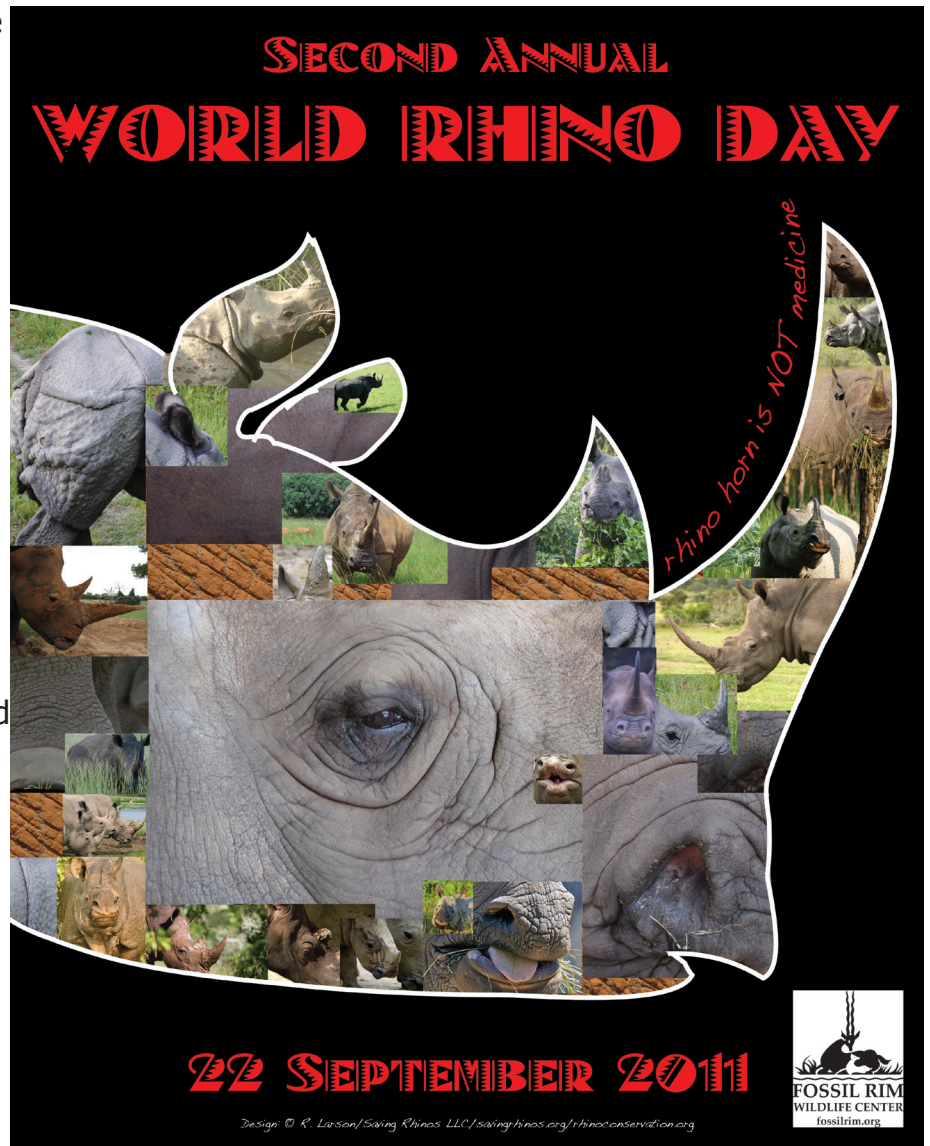


# World Rhino Day Art Contest Rules

1. Student must attend one of Glen Rose ISD schools.
2. Student may enter only one picture.
3. Rhino(s) must be the most prominent part of art submitted.
4. Contestants may use any medium (paint, watercolors, colored pencils, art pencil, crayons or chalk etc).
5. Art should be done on clean white paper with no lines and
6. no smaller than 8 x 10.
7. Artwork needs to be matted. Matted frames can be construction paper, or regular matting material.
8. Child's name should be printed on the back of the picture along with teacher's name and grade.
9. There will be four divisions determined by grade.
  - K-2
  - 3-5
  - 6-8
  - 9-12
10. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be awarded in each division. All contestants will receive a participation certificate.
11. First prize in each division will receive a prize from Fossil Rim, including a membership for one year for 4 people.
12. Art will be collected from each campus on Tues. Sept. 20.
13. Awards will be announced Sept. 22nd 7:30 at the Hollywood and Vine.
14. Art submitted is the property of Fossil Rim Wildlife Center, and will be displayed and sold September 22nd at the Hollywood and Vine.
15. All proceeds from art donated by GRISD students will go to the rhinos at Fossil Rim.
