- *Dicerorhinus sumatrensis sumatrensis*: **CRITICALLY ENDANGERED**
- *Dicerorhinus sumatrensis harrissoni*: **CRITICALLY ENDANGERED**
- *Dicerorhinus sumatrensis lasiotis*: **POSSIBLY EXTINCT**

Historical range: Himalayan foothills in Bhutan and NE India, through southern China (Yunnan), Myanmar, Thailand, Cambodia, Lao PDR, Viet Nam and the Malay Peninsula, and onto the islands of Sumatra and Borneo in Indonesia.

Current range: Indonesia and Malaysia.
